Prizes: \$500 will be awarded in each of two categories: graduate and undergraduate

Presentation: Students will have the opportunity to present their research in poster board presentation format during the conference. Poster boards will be set-up at various locations throughout the tradeshow floor, and you will be expected to answer questions by judges and conference participants.

Format: Students will be provided with 8' wide x 4' high poster boards to display their research (see picture).
